



## Student Application Instructions FOR CLUB USE ONLY

The attached student application documents contain pages that require club, parent/guardian, and RYLA student attention and signature. Completed documents requiring signatures must be sent to me for processing.

**Please note:** School counselors and student clubs advisors are very busy in May with end of year testing. Getting them to take time to identify a student for RYLA during this time is asking too much of them.

Once the student(s) is identified, take the lead. Historically speaking, students do not complete their application without some nudging. Work directly with the student, first to let them know about your club's monetary sponsorship and that you are excited about their RYLA attendance. Stay in contact with them until they have completed and mailed their application.
